HOW TO BUILD REACH ON FACEBOOK

BEAT THE ALGORITHM

- You get what you put into any social media platform. If you want the audience you need to be there.
- Posting at least once a day (you can schedule this)
- Responding to questions, comments, encouraging conversation
- Becoming a member of other relevant Facebook groups.

BLUEPRINT FOR VIDEO SUCCESS

- Meet Facebook guidelines (3 minutes+, subtitles, cover photo)
- Post EVERGREEN video consistently.
- Send links to all parties immediately (DMO, businesses featured, chamber of commerce, MLA/MP)
- Community Facebook groups that allow it
- Personal page, ask friends to share.

Videos that are immediately shared within the first few hours ALWAYS outperform.

WHAT ABOUT YOUTUBE

- 1. Long term goal.
- 2. Some audience is migrating but most are not.
- 3. SEO driven + takes more time to build an audience.


MOBILE VIDEO TIPS

APPROACHING VIDEO

- Like writing you need to plan day story in advance. Shooting on the fly makes editing HARD.
- Chronological is easiest.
- Talking heads are boring. SHOW don't TELL people what things are like.
- YES. You need to be on camera. People connect with REAL people. Your age, gender, etc does not matter. There is an audience for everyone.
- Shoot the same intros, explanations a few times.
- Share your experience. People are impacted by how things affect you.

EASY TECHNICAL TIP

- Of course the golden hour is best but not always realistic so learn how to easily change exposure.
- Easier to fix while shooting than in editing.



EDITING STRATEGY

- I prefer shorter clips of under a minute, easier to deal with in editing
- Review all clips, remove mistake/junk clips
- Organize into theme folders: music intro, me intro-ing, specific businesses or events, outro
- Review clips in each folder, organize them into order of when they would appear, removing clips I can't use
- THEN open editing software and begin to drop in clips, working on edits

TECHNICAL ELEMENTS

- Essentials (Gorillapod, mobile adaptor, Lavalier mic)
- Add ons (Car mount, Moment wide angle lens, Gimbal)
- What I now use (Sony ZV1, GoPro9, wireless mic, drone)
- Edit on whatever free software you have (iMovie, Filmora) or outsource
- Shoot horizontal and vertical

It's OKAY to be a beginner. You will get better. It becomes easier and faster.
